Reminder: 2024 Poppy Assessment, Special Levy, and Poppy Fund Statement Due January 31, 2025

Dear Comrades,

We trust you had a joyful and restful holiday season!

This is a friendly reminder that the 2024 Poppy Assessment, Special Levy, and Poppy Fund Statement are due by **January 31**, **2025**.

Key Updates and Requirements

Poppy Assessment

- Beginning in 2024, the PEC has approved a single Poppy Assessment remittance (replacing the previous two).
- Branches must remit 4.5% of all revenues earned between January 1 and December 31, 2024.

Special Levy

- A special levy of 3.5% of all Poppy revenues earned in 2024 has been approved by the PEC.
- This levy supports:
 - Recruitment of an additional Service Bureau Officer and Poppy Coordinator, enhancing training and Branch support.

Poppy Fund Statement

- Submission of the Poppy Fund Statement is required per the Poppy Manual.
- The reporting period is January 1 to December 31, 2024.

Note: You may combine the Poppy Assessment and Special Levy remittance into one cheque, but both the Poppy Assessment form and Special Levy form must accompany the submission.

Submission Instructions

To ensure timely submission, please:

- 1. Complete the attached Poppy Assessment, Special Levy, and Poppy Fund Statement forms.
- 2. Include Poppy account statements for the period January 1 to December 31, 2024.
- 3. Submit the completed forms and remittance (cheque) by January 31, 2025.
