When Veterans need help, they often turn to their local Legion Branch. If you are aware of a Veteran who is homeless or about to become homeless, you don't have to help alone. We can help, too!

The Legion Foundation BC/Yukon has recently updated the <u>Veteran Homelessness Program</u>. This program can now provide help to Veterans with:

- Ongoing rent & utility payments
- Overdue rent & utilities
- Rent & utility deposits
- Locating housing & setting up viewings
- Moving & furniture
- Tenant insurance
- Hotel stays when Veterans have housing that isn't available yet
- Referrals to more help (Provincial Service Officers for VAC claims, mental health counselling, transitional housing, apartment kits, BC Housing applications & more)

The Veterans Homelessness Program is 100% funded by the Government of Canada. There are other organizations in BC that have received the same grant to help homeless Veterans (John Howard Society Victoria, VRS/Legion Veterans Village, RCMP Veterans Association, and Veterans Transition Network). We work closely with these groups, and with the Provincial Service Officers at BC/Yukon Command, to coordinate services and ensure Veterans are cared for.

How to Apply:

Step 1: Determine if the Veteran is eligible

They are eligible if they:

- Are a former member of the Canadian Armed Forces (Rangers or Reservists) or RCMP
- Are currently homeless (including staying with friends, living in an RV, or in a shelter) or at-risk of becoming homeless (they have an eviction notice or are behind on rent about to receive one)

Step 2: Complete the Application Form

- Download <u>the form online</u> (attached to this circular)
- Call or text Maria: 604-312-5843 Maria can help Veterans fill out the form, too!

Step 3: Gather documents

• Proof of service documentation (if available)

Step 4: Submit the application

- Email the application and supporting documents to <u>vhp@legionbcyukonfoundation.ca</u>
- After submitting an application, a staff member will get in contact for next steps

With the addition of this program, the Legion Foundation now has three main ways to support Veterans experiencing homelessness or at-risk of homelessness.

- 1. Operation: Leave the Streets Behind
 - Provides Comfort Backpacks and Apartment Kits to Veterans in need
