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




WHAT IS GOOD GOVERNANCE?

The Good (basic things to get right)


- "Duties" of the Board/Executive
 - Duty of Care Ensure prudent use of all assets, including property, people and good will/reputation
 - Duty of Loyalty Make decisions that are in the best interest of the Branch, even if this is not necessarily in the best interest of an individual or themselves
 - Duty of Obedience Ensure that the Branch obeys applicable laws and regulations, follows our own bylaws, and adheres to the stated mission
 - Fiduciary Duty Make informed decisions, respect the decision of the Board (even if you didn't agree with it)



Bylaw Structure

- BC/Yukon Command Bylaws
- Branch Bylaws
 - In absence of these, Branch Pro Forma is used

- Poppy Manual
- Rules of Procedure for Legion Meetings
- Ritual, Awards and Protocol Manual
- Code of Ethics Policy



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- Don't follow The General Bylaws (GBLs)
 - If you are being paid to work, you can't serve on the Executive (112.a)
 - A President who resigns before the end of their term is not the immediate Past President (114.b)
 - Any branch immediate Past President who missed 3 consecutive meetings (executive or branch or both), shall cease to hold office (613.b)
 - Conflict of Interest (301.c)
 - Is deemed to exist when a member has, through their office, influence or knowledge, a real or perceived interest in, or effect on the outcome of any complaint or appeal made under the provisions of this Article.



"My fees are quite high, and yet you say you have little money.

I think I'm seeing a conflict of interest here."

- Don't follow BC/Yukon Command Bylaws
 - Proxy voting is not permitted at Branch elections (603)
 - Spending without approval of the General Membership, except:
 - Normal operating expenses & yearly budget (619.a)
 - Emergency things needs to be ratified (619.b)
 - No pictures/video/posts of alcoholic beverages at the Branch can be posted publicly without written permission (1301)

- Don't follow Branch Bylaws
 - Expenditures over \$10,000 must first be approved by BC/Yukon Command
 - All monies in excess of \$100 (or \$200) including petty cash but not including Gaming shall be paid by cheque with 2 signatures
 - Whenever a repair or replacement exceeds \$500 (or \$1,000), bids should be solicited from at least 2 (or 3) suppliers

- Don't follow Rules of Procedure for Legion Meetings
 - All evidence of (bar) drinks removed prior to opening of the meeting
 - More in my session this afternoon (on Effective Meetings)
- Don't follow best practice
 - Signing authorities
 - No discussion or evaluation of employee performance or wages
 - No discussion of individual Veterans in need (Poppy funds)



Tips & Tricks (to avoid the Ugly)

- Reference the "higher up" bylaws whenever possible
- Know the common bylaw clauses money!
- Ensure you are using the most current bylaws
- Language is important Must/May/Shall
- Never too late to do the right thing
- If it's not working, consider changing







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
